NOTICE OF PROPOSED AMENDED REGULATION**

**REGULATION NUMBER AND TITLE: 6.008 Postsecondary College-level Preparatory Testing, Placement, and Instruction for State Universities**

**SUMMARY:**

The proposed amendment to Board Regulation 6.008 Postsecondary College-level Preparatory Testing, Placement, and Instruction for State Universities reflects placement test changes and aligns with standards outlined in the Florida State Board of Education Rule 6A-10.03515, Common Placement Testing, and Instruction. Doing so provides for consistent treatment of students across the state. The amendment also eliminates references to discontinued College Board SAT examinations.
