## FLORIDA BOARD OF GOVERNORS NOTICE OF PROPOSED AMENDED REGULATION

**DATE**: June 28, 2017

**REGULATION NUMBER AND TITLE:** Regulation 6.002 Admission of Undergraduate First-Time-in-College, Degree-Seeking Freshmen

**SUMMARY:** Board of Governors Regulation 6.002 has been amended to align admission test score requirements with scores required for college-level coursework in addition to further clarifying language. A summary of the proposed changes to this regulation is as follows:

- x Eliminates Table One of the current regulation and replaces it with a statement indicating that a student may be considered for standard admission if the student has a 2.50 or higher grade point average (current requirement), presents an official SAT and/or ACT, qualifies for college-level placement per Board Regulation 6.008, and meets the high school credits listed in the new Table One.
- x Clarifies the 2016 Redesigned SAT and minimum ACT composite score required for students who are graduates of a high school educational program that is not measured in Carnegie Units.
- x Clarifies that a student must be eligible for college-level work per Board of Governors Regulation 6.008 in order to be eligible for the Talented Twenty designation.
- x Eliminates vague concordance test outdated essay language.
